The Elizabeth Clark Emergency Fund addresses emergency needs of individuals and families in crisis. The fund is a last resort and limited to assistance with obtaining clothing, furniture and household items at any of Goodwill Industries retail stores serving Summit, Portage, Medina, Ashland and Richland Counties (locations shown below).

Eligible individuals and families include those who are not financially able to secure clothing, furniture and other household items. Hardship, emergency situations and unforeseen circumstances are considered when a determination is made. Generally referral by another community agency is required in order to access the fund.
